Make a place name card for each 'party guest'. Clap, stamp and use your voice to make the sounds of fireworks. What junk materials can you use to make instruments? What does sprinkle rice or pasta onto a baking tray sound like? What about ripping or scrunching paper?
	<p>Health and self-care</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get yourself dressed every day. Practise putting on your gloves by yourself. 	
PE	<p>Dance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count back from 10 and then blast off like a firework. Imagine you are a firework exploding in the sky. Will you make a big shape or a long thin shape? Can you sink back down to the ground? Will you come straight down or will you turn and twist? Will you be quick or slow? Shoot up like a rocket and make a different shape each time. Once you've practised different fireworks, put your dance to your favourite music.
