




term and are now all refreshed and ready for this busy time in the lead up to the end of

In Maths we will be learning more about place value and completing tasks involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be thinking more about using what we already know to solve word problems and looking closely at numbers in order to identify patterns that will help We are setting the challenge of creating models using recycled materials inspired by the characters in our focus books. We hope to see imaginative models made of all sorts of junk appearing in our classrooms soon.

In PE, 3AY will continue with swimming and 3SB will be working on their gymnastics skills.

Both classes will continue to work with the music teachers from In Harmony where they will be learning lots of new songs as well as the basics of rhythm and pitch. Our musical genre of the term is music of the 1980's so we will be listening to some classic hits!

In RE, we will be marking the run up to Christmas by finding out about the beliefs of Christianity. We will be learning about festivals and finding out what Christian do when they attend church. We will also be learning about the events of the Christmas story and why they are important to Christians.

In computing, we will continue to learn about staying safe

online but we will also be learning how to make the internet work for us by searching for important and accurate information.

We will also be learning to speak a little Spanish.

We will continue to work in our phonics and reading groups every morning. We are committed to helping every child become a confident reader and all the children will work in small groups to help them develop their phonics and reading skills working at their own level.
